North London Waste Plan and London Legacy Development Corporation Memorandum of Understanding

I am writing on behalf of the seven North London Boroughs engaged in the North London Waste Plan (NLWP) in my capacity as chair of our Planning Members Group. The London Boroughs of Barnet, Camden, Enfield, Hackney, Haringey, Islington and Waltham Forest are working together as planning authorities on the NLWP which will set a planning framework for waste management issues for the boroughs up to 2031.

Because the LLDC is planning authority for part of Hackney and Waltham Forest, officers have been negotiating a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the North London Boroughs and the Legacy Corporation under the Duty to Co-operate. The Boroughs have been kept informed throughout this process.

As set out in the document, the MoU will need to be formally ratified by each Borough separately but I can say on behalf of the NLWP Planning Members Group that Members will be recommending acceptance of the finalised MoU by each Borough. I understand that you have agreed the document on behalf of the LLDC. Further scrutiny of the document by Borough solicitors has resulted in some proposed drafting changes to clarify terms in the document. These do not change the substance of the document and I believe you will find the proposed changes acceptable. I suggest we ask officers to finalise the wording of the MoU to go to the Boroughs for ratification.

I will write to you again when the MoU has been ratified by all of the Boroughs. I would like to thank you for your co-operation in reaching this stage and look forward to continuing engagement between our two organisations on strategic waste matters as set out in the MoU.
