Thank you for your request for information, received by London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) on 2 October 2012. You asked us the following three questions:

"The full severance pay to former LLDC chair Daniel Moylan, to include pay for notice period not worked and other compensation.

The full severance pay and compensation package made to Andrew Altman following his departure as chief executive.

The full severance pay and compensation package made to Margaret Ford following her departure as chair of the LLDC".

The Corporation is not obliged to confirm or deny the existence of a pay and compensation package for Andrew Altman as such information represents personal information which has also been obtained in confidence as part of the arrangements agreed with him for his leaving the service of the Corporation (see ss41 and 42 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000). The public interest in non disclosure outweighs any public interest in disclosure given that disclosure would be a breach of the Corporation's agreement with him.

The payments made to Margaret Ford and Daniel Moylan as Chairs of the Corporation are part of the information held by the Corporation with a view to its publication for inspection by members of the public as part of the audit of the Corporation's accounts in June 2013. This information is therefore exempt from public now (see s22 of the Act) and we see no overriding public interest in the release now of such information about payments made after they ceased to be Chairs of the Corporation.
