Thank you for your request for information, received on 26 November 2012.

I have set out below our response to each one of your questions following your order:

(1) The expected total cost of the administration and works to the post 2012 Olympic Games to form the Queen Elizabeth (why not II) Park development/reinstatement.

Answer: The budget currently available for transformation of Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park (the Park) is £292m. The administration costs of the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) are available in our Annual Report (available on line and to download at www.londonlegacy.co.uk/media/OPLC_Annual_Report_2012_260712.pdf).

(2) Is this cost included in the 2012 Olympics final cost of £9.6 Billion?

Answer: The overall cost of the Games is forecast at £8.921 billion, a saving of £377m on the £9.298 billion budget. The transformation cost of the Park is included within this figure.

(3) Does it include the conversion of the athletes' accommodation into flats and the conversion back to a swimming pool of the Aquatic Centre?

Answer: The cost of the conversion of the Aquatics Centre is included in the Legacy Corporation's budget for transformation of the Park.
