Thank you for your request for information, received on 4th January 2012. You asked us the following questions:

Please provide information concerning the role of the ODA in this procurement together with the additional safeguards introduced to ensure that ODA could not exert undue influence in the selection of Mace, a member of the ODA's Delivery Partner.

The ODA's only contributions were to make available the scope of services of their Delivery Partner, CLM, for OPLC to modify for its own use, and then subsequently to facilitate the use by OPLC of ODA's e-tendering portal and AWARD evaluation system.

The ODA had no role in the establishment of OPLC's procurement strategy for the Transformation Project Management Partner and played no part in the procurement process. Procurement, evaluation, interviews and recommendation were carried out exclusively by members of OPLC's Transformation Team.
