Thank you for your request for information, received on 17 April 2013. You asked us the following questions:

“Who owns the Olympic Stadium and the land it is situated on?”

Will the Limited Liability Partnership formed between the London Legacy Development Corporation and the London Borough of Newham give the London Borough of Newham any property rights to the Stadium and/or the land it is situated on?”

London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC) owns the freehold to the land on which the Stadium sits and the Stadium itself. It will grant a lease to the Limited Liability Partnership (LLP) for the Stadium island site to allow it to manage the Stadium. The LLP (called E20 Stadium LLP) is a joint venture between LLDC and Newham Investments Limited (a wholly owned subsidiary of the London Borough of Newham); the LLP will have complete responsibility for the operation and management of the Stadium. It is therefore the LLP rather than the London Borough of Newham that will have property rights to the Stadium and the land it is situated on.
