Thank you for your request for information, received on 3 July 2013. You asked us the following question:

"What have been the operating costs of all the Olympic and Paralympic venues since the end of the Olympics and the transferral of these assets into public ownership? Please itemise costs per venue."

From the time the London Legacy Development Corporation (the Legacy Corporation) took responsibility for the venues within the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, and until the end of June 2013, the site has been under transformation with no operation of the Olympic or Paralympic venues. Accordingly, there have been no operating costs. This is distinct from maintenance, security and transformational costs as provided in our previous responses to you.

The term Venue has been defined as an area within Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park that held a sporting event during the Olympics / Paralympics 2012 that the Legacy Corporation took responsibility for at some time after the end of the Olympic / Paralympics.
