Thank you for your request for information, received on 9 August 2013. Please accept my apologies again that a response was not sent to you sooner. Additional training on the Freedom of information Act 2000 and the handling of requests is being organised for all staff.

In your original request, you asked us to take whatever enforcement action is necessary to ensure that the planning grant conditions were completely satisfied in relation to Woolwich Common with regards to the post-Olympic restoration and the unsatisfactory condition of the Common.

The London Legacy Development Corporation (the Legacy Corporation) is not the planning authority for any area outside of the current Legacy Corporation boundary and as such we do not have jurisdiction over land elsewhere.
