When will LBTH be responding?
ADM – Noted that LBTH Officers had requested further time to provide a response
and would be considering the application at a Planning Contributions Overview Panel
(PCOP) in early December. ADM noted that a committee date had not been
identified.
Commented that this meant they were 'figuring out what they wanted'.
Asked what the LLDC's view was on the school and the situation with AH
ADM – Responded that the FIAAP, which was very recently adopted, identified a
school on the site. The supporting wording in the FIAAP identified the school as a
priority which should be considered to have primacy ahead of non-transport needs for
any scheme on the site. LLDC would assess the application against this and other
policies when considering AH provision.
Noted he had been involved in the FIAAP process and thought that the
policy suggested that the school allocation was either the NW site or the school
within PDZ 4 LCS. asked how this impacted the LCS school in PDZ 4.

ADM – Responded that the LCS was a parameters based outline application which sought and gained approval for a school/D use class floorspace within the southern extent of PDZ 4 and as this is what had been given permission this was what was expected to come forward.
