Thank you for your request for information, received on 21 August 2013.

You requested the following from the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation):

“I am writing under the Freedom of Information Act and Environmental Information Regulations 2004 to request copies of emails between the London Legacy Development Corporation and the developer of Neptune Wharf on Wyke Road in Fish Island (LLDC Ref: 12/00210/OUT) and/or his managing agent between the dates of 18 November 2012 and 21 August 2013?”

From our preliminary assessment, it is clear that we will not be able to answer your request without further clarification. Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 makes provision for public authorities to refuse requests for information where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the appropriate limit, which for this authority is set at £450.

In order to provide you with the information on the scale that you have requested would require staff members to review over 1 GB of electronic information. It has been estimated that it would take 3 persons in excess of 5 days to go through and identify the relevant information, which will exceed the appropriate limit.

We estimate that it will take us in excess of the applicable limit to determine the appropriate material, retrieve and extract the information in reference to your request. Therefore, your request will not be processed further.

You may wish to refine your request by narrowing its scope by being more specific about what information you particularly wish to obtain, including any dates or period of time relevant to the information required.

If you are unhappy with our response to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to:
