Thank you for your request for information, received on 28 August 2013. You sent a list of 50 Architectural firms and asked us the following question:

"Please can I find out how much the LLDC (formerly OPLC) paid to the following architects between the organisation's start (in 2009) and the present?

Please also include the total paid to each architect over the timeframe."

The London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) hold this information for the Legacy Corporation and the previous legal body, the Olympic Park Legacy Company (OPLC) from April 2010. From the founding of the OPLC May 2009 until March 2010, the finance function was undertaken by London Development Agency (LDA). Upon the closure of the LDA these records were transferred to the Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG). The information requested from April 2010 until July 2013 is provided in Appendix A. Please be advised that the information includes all payments to the firms listed and these figures are not just for the provision of architectural services.
