FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 – REQUEST 14-001

Thank you for your request for information, which we received on 7 January 2014. You asked us:

“Please may I receive an up to date list of subcontractors, suppliers and consultants involved with the demolition of 1500 council owned properties and other buildings and the construction of 7000 residential units, together with the regeneration of Canning Town centre. This will include improvements to the Custom House, new medical centre, replacement schools for Hallsville School and Keir Hardie School, construction and refurbishment of offices, retail units, a Sainsbury's supermarket, shopping centre improvements, restaurants, leisure centres, library and hotel. (Canning Town & Custom House)”.

Unfortunately the information you requested is not held by the London Legacy Development Corporation (the Legacy Corporation), and we are therefore unable to provide further assistance to you in progressing your request.
