Thank you for your request for information, received on 14 January 2014. You asked us the following questions:

*"Please send me a list of all clubs or facilities from which the London Legacy Development Corporation has bought land using its powers of Compulsory Purchase Order since its establishment in 2012. Specifically, I understand that the Corporation was established as a Mayoral Development Corporation with powers of compulsory purchase, and I am requesting a list of all the instances when the Corporation has exercised those powers to purchase land or facilities from public clubs, centres or associations (including, but not limited to, sports clubs, youth clubs and activity centres)".*

The London Legacy Development Corporation response is as follows:

Since its establishment in 2012, the London Legacy Development Corporation (the Legacy Corporation) has not used its Compulsory Purchase powers.
