Thank you for your information request, received on 22 September 2014. You asked us to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*"Please provide information on the property / properties formerly known as "2 Lock Keepers Cottages".*

*I believe this may now be the address, but I could be wrong:  
Lock Cottage, Dace Rd, E3 2NN*

*I am looking for information on:*

- the current owner of the property / properties*
- what plans are currently in place for the property / properties*
- what the property / properties are currently being used for*
- when and how the property / properties will be sold*
- any other information held by London Legacy relating to the properties."*

The London Legacy Development Corporation (the Legacy Corporation) do not own this property and do not hold information on the current owner of the property, what plans the owner may currently have in place for the property, what the property is currently being used for or when and how the property will be sold.

As the planning authority, the Legacy Corporation have received no planning applications in relation to this property.

The Legacy Corporation has recently released its Local Plan 2015 to 2031. The Local Plan sets out policies and allocations that relate to the area around the property. Following consultation the plan is scheduled to be adopted in late spring of 2015. The property is within the extended Fish Island conservation area. The approval to designate the extension to the conservation area was agreed by the Legacy Corporation Board at their meeting of 30 April 2014.
