INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 14-057

Thank you for your information request, received on 18 December 2014. You asked us to provide the following information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

“what exactly was to have been built on the site next to the Olympic Stadium which Newham claims is now to be occupied by the school, if this known to you.

Newham claimed in its report that this decision is a joint Newham/LLDC decision. Can you please confirm that the LLDC is involved in this decision.

If you have the information please provide maps showing the proposed locations of the school at the two sites.”

I have set out below our response to your questions.

The site next to the Olympic Stadium was originally earmarked as potential land for development at some point in the future. No plans were progressed and no planning application has been submitted in relation to its future development.

The London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC) is a party to any decisions made about the future development of site next to the Olympic Stadium.

No plans are currently available as they are still in development. The LLDC is withholding this information under EIR exception 12(4)(d).

EIR 12(4) - a public authority may refuse to disclose information to the extent that—

(d) the request relates to material which is still in the course of completion, to unfinished documents or to incomplete data;

The public interest in this area is recognised and acknowledged, however despite the public interest in disclosing this information, the plans are still in development and are still subject

to revision and we consider the balance in this instance to be against disclosing this information at this stage. Once a planning application in relation to the school or any other future development at the site has been submitted, these will be publicised by the Local Planning Authority and the public will be able to review any plans submitted.
