Thank you for your information request, received on 29 January 2015. You asked us to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"can you please confirm, as per FOI procedure, that the issue of state aid was discussed at the LLDC Board Meetings of 27 September 2012 and 15 October 2012 and at the LLDC Stadium Committee 27 September 2012 and at the LLDC Stadium Committee 15 October 2012? Can you also please send me minutes, by email, of those meetings in so far as they refer to the state aid issue."

I can confirm that the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) held Board meetings on 27 September 2012 and 15 October 2012, however the issue of state aid was not discussed at either of these meetings, in either the Public or the Private Sessions. Therefore, in relation to your request, the Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested.

The Stadium Committee did not meet on the 27 September 2012 or 15 October 2012, therefore in relation to your request, the Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested.
