INTERNAL REVIEW - REFERENCE 15-014

We refer to your email of 9 June 2015 where you requested an internal review under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) with regard to the response you received from the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) in relation to your information request reference as above.

The internal review has been completed and the findings and recommendations of the internal review are as follows:

1. Findings and recommendations:

- 1.1. The internal review team's opinion was that there were a number of redactions of information on the basis of commercial sensitivity that, on balance, could be released into the public domain. The remaining redactions could be justified for reasons of being commercially sensitive, items of personal data or on the basis of prevention / detection of crime and should remain redacted.
- 1.2. The internal review team recommended that the two leases should be released with the information disclosed as set out in the tables attached in Annex A.
- 1.3. The Stadium Island Site lease redactions have been revised following the findings of the Panel. The revised Lease is in Annex B.
- 1.4. The Community Track lease redactions have been revised following the findings of the Panel. The revised Lease is in Annex C.

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you may appeal directly to the Information Commissioner at the address given below. You should do this within two months of our final decision. There is no charge for making an appeal.
