Thank you for your information request, received on 9 April 2015. You asked us to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

- "1. Did The Mayor of London direct LLDC to treat the state intervention involved in the stadium lease agreement between LLDC and E20 Stadium LLP as not constituting state aid?
- 2. Did The Mayor of London direct LLDC to treat the state intervention involved in the financial contributions from the London Borough of Newham and LLDC to E20 Stadium LLP as not constituting state aid?
- 3. Did The Mayor of London direct LLDC to treat the state intervention involved through concessionary licences from E20 Stadium LLP to private undertakings as not constituting state aid?"

I have provided our response to your request below:

The London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) has conducted searches for the information you have requested through the Legacy Corporation's email archive and fileserver. These searches confirm that the Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested. The Legacy Corporation has not received a Mayoral direction which makes any reference to state aid.
