INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 15-045

Dear Sir / Madam,

Thank you for your information request, received on 3 August 2015. You asked us to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Please provide under freedom of information details of what has happened to the following equipment used in the London 2012 Olympics:

Hurdles

Long jump track and pit

High jump equipment

Running track (both practise and main track)

Badminton nets

Gymnastics equipment

Table tennis tables

Volley Ball nets

Boxing rings”

The London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) is only responsible for the following equipment listed in your request:

- Running track (main)
- Long jump track and pit

The main running track and the long jump track and pit remain in situ at the Stadium.

The remaining equipment listed was retained by London Organising Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games (LOCOG) and was not transferred to the Legacy Corporation to distribute.

Our understanding is that the following equipment was distributed to the national governing bodies of the various sports, though we hold no information to confirm this.

- Volley Ball nets
- Badminton nets
- Gymnastics equipment
- Table tennis tables
- Boxing rings

In the case of the remaining equipment, we can confirm that this was handed over by LOCOG to UK Athletics for distribution.

- Hurdles
- High jump equipment
- Running track (warm-up)

Though not directly involved, the Legacy Corporation do know that UK Athletics (UKA) arranged reuse of the warm-up running track as walkways at various venues:- Alexander Stadium, Birmingham; Gateshead International Stadium; Pop Up Athletics events – i.e. Horse Guards Parade; National Indoor Arena; Allianz Park – Shaftesbury Barnet. UKA also have some strips in store for use at the Olympic Stadium for media mixed zone walkways.
