INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 15-051

Dear [REDACTED],

Thank you for your information request, received on 24 August 2015. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Can you inform me of the following costs whether expended or budgeted in relation to the former Olympic Stadium in Queen Elizabeth park.

- 1) The total cost in pounds sterling of installing of the original orange Mondo running track for the London 2012 Olympics*
- 2) The budgeted cost in pounds sterling to replace the Mondo running track running for the 2017 Athletics world championships*
- 3) The total cost in pounds sterling to install the grass turf and Desso grassmaster pitch for 2015 events including the Rugby World Cup.*
- 4) The budgeted cost in pounds sterling to replace the grass turf and Desso grassmaster pitch in advance of West Ham taking up occupancy as the resident football team.”*

In relation to your first question, the Legacy Corporation does not hold this information. The Olympic Delivery Authority (ODA) was responsible for the track at the time of the London 2012 Olympics. On the closure of the ODA, their records were transferred to the Department of Culture, Media and Sports. For your remaining requests, the information that the Legacy Corporation holds does not break down the contract price or activity schedule in sufficient detail to be able to specifically identify, retrieve or extract the information you have requested.

Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 makes provision for public authorities to refuse requests for information where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the

appropriate limit, which for this authority is set at £450, based on 18 hours work at a set £25 per hour).

We estimate that it will take us in excess of the applicable time limit to determine the appropriate material, plus the additional time required for the retrieval and extraction of the information related to your request. Therefore, your request will not be processed further and in accordance with the FOIA this letter acts as a Refusal Notice.

If you are unhappy with our response to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to:
