

Use of IBC Cabins

These are being stored at Rick Roberts Way, south of Pudding Mill Lane in Newham, for re-use by Grassroots Interim Uses and other relevant LLDC supported programmes which meet our priority themes. Available information:

- 2 x long units, 3 x large to medium sized units and 3 x small units (including shower/toilet blocks)
- Each bay is self-contained (approx 2m x 3m) - so could make longer or shorter buildings as required.
- Each bay has 2-3 complete sides with one or more fully exposed
- Toilets and all lighting removed but these are still being stored in one of the cabins so could be reinstalled
- Footings seem to allow installation on relatively flat but rough surface - no screed required
- Original design for summer use provision (not currently insulated for winter use) - steel structure only covered by single layer of timber boarding on joints between modules
- Some patching required - holes for extracts etc.
