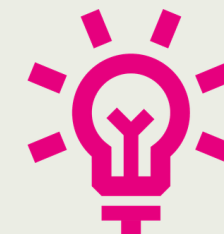
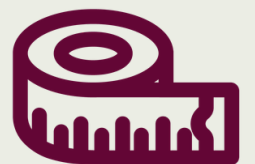

Backstage at ABBA Voyage: Lighting, Audio & Production Workshop Tuesday 27 - Thursday 29 October	A unique behind-the-scenes industry experience where participants work directly with ABBA Voyage's technical teams to explore live event production, lighting design, audio engineering and stage management. Young people will create and operate their own mini lighting show while gaining insight into careers within the entertainment industry.	• Lighting and audio production skills. • Technical show setup. • Creative design and live production. • Teamwork in professional setting. • Insight into backstage careers.
Knitwear Industry Skills: From Machine to Market Monday 26 - Tuesday 27 October	Discover how knitwear goes from an idea to a finished product in this three-day hands-on workshop. You'll work as part of a team, designing and creating a large-scale knitted piece using an industrial knitting machine while exploring the creative and technical processes behind the fashion industry. Across three days you'll develop a concept, select yarns, experiment with machine knitting, and bring a collective design to life for the final showcase. Along the way, you'll gain insight into how knitwear is designed, manufactured and sold. You'll also explore a range of careers across the industry, from designer and technician to pattern cutter, production specialist, buyer and retailer.	• Understand the knitwear industry supply chain. • Learn to use a knitting machine. • Explore the range of careers within knitwear and fashion. • Understand how small knitwear items move from maker to market.
