Thank you for your information request, received on 8 February 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*“Has the transfer of the section of the park west of the River Lea to LB Hackney occurred as planned? If it has been delayed, what is the reason?”*

Following the clarification received on 2 March 2016, which identified the specific section of land, the Legacy Corporation can confirm that the land parcel you have identified, known as North Parklands, was transferred from the Legacy Corporation back to the London Borough of Hackney (Hackney) on 17 April 2014. The Legacy Corporation then leased the land back from Hackney under a 40 year lease.
