Thank you for your information request, received on 7 March 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"Could you please provide copies of any correspondence to/from any representative of West Ham United that refers in any way to the digital wrap around the Olympic Stadium since 1 January 2016.

Please include any meeting minutes where this was discussed with West Ham or their representatives."

The Legacy Corporation holds no correspondence or meeting minutes either to or from any representative of West Ham United since 1 January 2016 that refers in any way to the digital wrap around the Olympic Stadium.

A revised planning application has recently been submitted for an alternative wrap for the Stadium which, while it includes a screen, is mainly comprised of fabric banners so is not being referred to by Legacy Corporation as a "digital wrap". The planning application is available to view on the Legacy Corporation planning register under reference: 16/00106/ADV
