Thank you for your information request, received on 22 March 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Please may i request a complete list of subcontractors, suppliers and consultants that have or will be involved with the Conversion of the London Olympic Stadium into a multi-use venue capable of hosting football (60,000 capacity), athletics (74,000 capacity), concerts (80,000 capacity) and community events/activities. The stadium to be fully compliant with FIFA and IAAF standards. Works to include the extension/replacement of the existing stadium roof to cover the majority of seating, the installation of general spectator and additional hospitality facilities, along with office/retail accommodation and the provision of a warm-up community track and field facility to be located adjacent to the stadium., please may i request this under the freedom of information act.”

I confirm that the Legacy Corporation hold this information, however, under Section 21 of FOIA, we are not required to provide information in response to a request if it is already reasonably accessible to you. The information you requested is available on our website within our publication scheme as it was requested in an earlier FOI request.
