Thank you for your information request, received on 23 March 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"Could you please tell me how much the London Legacy Development Corporation have spent in legal costs, trying to keep the terms of their deal with West Ham for the Olympic Stadium private, since the information commissioner ruled the terms of the deal should be made public in September?"

The Legacy Corporation can confirm that they hold some information relevant to your request.

The Legacy Corporation is a functional body of the Greater London Authority and its internal legal services are provided under a shared services agreement by Transport for London Legal. The Legacy Corporation does not hold information on the amount of internal legal costs incurred in dealing with the Legacy Corporation's appeal against the ICO decision, as in accordance with normal practice internal legal costs were not recorded or itemised.

The amount of external legal costs, incurred in instructing Counsel of 11KBW to advise and to represent LLDC at the appeal, is £19,200 plus VAT.
