Thank you for your information request, received on 10 May 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“How much work, in terms of the conversion of the Park, still remains to be done, what is the estimated cost of that work and how does that cost compare with the previously stated conversion budget?”

The post-Olympic conversion of the Park is complete. Park transformation costs are £292 million.

The Park transformation costs were funded by £246.2 million from the Olympic and Paralympic Games Public Sector Funding Package and £45.8 million from the Olympic Park Legacy Company's (OPLC) Capital Works budgets.
