Thank you for your information request, received on 22 June 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*I have read the story in the link below regarding fit out of part of the Olympic Stadium concourse.*

*As there have been numerous press articles and a previous case regarding the terms of West Ham United's rental deal of the Olympic Stadium and the costs incurred I was wishing to ascertain who was bearing the costs of creation, installation and maintenance of these 'tributes' at the Olympic Stadium as I cannot clearly define this from the publicly available rental agreement.*

*I would be grateful if you could advise me accordingly of the details. Please be aware that I do not necessarily seek to know the costs at this time but purely who has responsibility for the costs*
