Thank you for your information request, received on 16 August 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

Please provide copies of transport & traffic studies in relation to the volume and type of traffic expected over the proposed all modes Monier Road Bridge (H14), and the expected impact on traffic volume and type over the vehicular bridge at White Post Lane.

The Legacy Corporation confirm that they hold information in relation to your request. The LCS planning application, submitted in September 2011 and updated in February 2012, included a comprehensive Transport Assessment, which included a detailed forecast of traffic numbers from 2014 to 2031, on roads within the Park and neighbouring communities.

For details of traffic numbers please see Appendix H, Package 5 (Carpenters Road/L03/Monier Road/E28), under planning reference 11/90621/OUTODA on [Web APAS](#), in the documents tab – a direct link has been provided below.

A commentary is provided in section H1.6.1 (pp.H13-H.17), and details of traffic flows can be found in section H2.1, from page H51 – please look at Package 5. The 2031 scenario includes projected traffic numbers using Monier Road Bridge and White Post Lane Bridge. This does not break vehicles down by type.
