Thank you for your information request, received on 16 August 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"Please provide the environmental impact study relating to the building of the H14 and H16 bridges."

The Legacy Corporation does not information in relation to your request. There is no specific Environmental Impact Assessment for the H14 and H16 bridges. There is the Legacy Communities Scheme EIA which deals with that development in its entirety (at outline stage), but does not split out the effects of the bridges. The planning application for the bridges will be reserved matters (i.e. details under the outline permission) and as long as they are within the parameters of the LCS then an EIA will not be produced. However, the detailed design will need to look at how the amenity of adjoining properties is protected. This is work that will be developed in the coming weeks as part of that detailed design process.
