Thank you for your information request, received on 16 August 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"Please provide the full business case for the H14 and H16 bridge development.

- Public sector good practice for business cases states as a minimum:
- The Strategic Case
- The Economic Case
- The Commercial Case
- The Financial Case
- The Management Case".

The Legacy Corporation do not hold the information you have requested. There is no specific business case for the proposed bridge development for H14 and H16 because this development formed part of the wider Legacy Communities Scheme (LCS), for which outline planning permission was granted in September 2012 (LPA Ref. 11/90621/OUTODA). Approval to enter into the LCS Section 106 Agreement and therefore implement the planning permission was agreed by the London Legacy Development Corporation Board on 27 September 2012.
