**INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 16103**

Thank you for your information request, received on 23 August 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*[Does Legacy Corporation have] a record of the CPO that was used to purchase Vittoria Wharf with? From my understanding there will have been an inquiry, and these files should theoretically be available.*

We believe the Compulsory Purchase Order (CPO) requested is the London Development Agency (Lower Lea Valley, Olympic and Legacy) Compulsory Purchase Order 2005', also known as the Olympic CPO. As mentioned on receipt of the request, a search has previously been undertaken for this document - <http://queenelizabetholympicpark.co.uk/~media/lldc/publication%20scheme/foi%20responses/201412/14053%20response.pdf>.

A new search was conducted across the Legacy Corporation fileserver, on the search terms "compulsory purchase". The Olympic CPO was not within the search results. The Legacy Corporation do hold records in archive that reference the CPO, however, we have estimated that the time required to locate, retrieve, identify if the information is held and if it is, extract the specific Vittoria Wharf references, and / or scan the entire document, will exceed the appropriate limit of £450, based on 18 hours works at a set £25 per hour as established under section 12 of the FOIA.

I have contacted the Greater London Authority (GLA) and they have advised me that they might hold an electronic copy, although they do not know for certain. They have suggested that you submit your request to them and they will undertake a search.
