Thank you for your information request, received on 14 November 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

"This FOI is in relation to the planning decision for the H16 bridge between Fish Island & Sweetwater:

Piles support will be required on the towpath on the Sweetwater side of the outlined H16 Bridge. Can you provide the results of any tests that have been done at this exactly location in relation to land contamination and environmental impact."
