## **INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 16131**

Dear

Thank you for your information request, received on 2 December 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

"Under protection of the FOIA 2000 please provide me with the following in PDF.

- 1. Soil Resistivity Test Result (SRTR) for the original stadium which was opened for the 2012 Olympics, hence, I would assume the SRTR pre-construction of the stadium will be around approx 2008.
- 2.SRTR for the new converted Stadium approx 2013/
- 3.SRTR for the Aquatic Centre approx 2008."

The Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested. The Legacy Corporation did not exist until April 2012. The Legacy Corporation's predecessor body, The Olympic Park Legacy Corporation did not exist until May 2009.

The Olympic Stadium was built by the Olympic Delivery Authority (ODA). On the closure of the ODA, some contractual information was novated over to the Legacy Corporation; however the majority of the ODA information was transferred to the Department of Culture, Media and Sports (DCMS). As an additional confirmation, a search was undertaken in the fileserver for the terms 'resistivity' and 'SRTR'. There were no results reported for either search.
