**INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 16135**

Thank you for your information request, received on 13 December 2016. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*“Re Lee Valley VeloPark Car Park, Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park, Abercrombie Road, E20 3AB*

*Please can you confirm whether ParkingEye (as the car park operator) or the landowner (Lee Valley Regional Park Authority) have approved planning consent for car parking signage and the use of APNR cameras at Lee Valley car park. If they do have consent, please can you provide details of when this was granted and provide the related documentation.*

*I have checked the planning register and have been unable to find this information.”*

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information relevant to your request.

In relation to your first question, LVRPA does not have approved consent for the car parking signage. Condition NNP.35 (signage) under planning reference 11/90766/FUMODA attached at Annex A requires that “no signs or advertisements shall be erected within the application site, without the prior written approval of the Local Planning Authority. Signage shall be in accordance with the approved Wayfinding Strategy submitted pursuant to condition NNP.82 on this permission.” I can confirm that LLDC PPDT (the local planning authority) has not specifically received an application to determine car park signage.

In relation to your second question, condition NNP.52 (CCTV) requires the installation of CCTV cameras within the site to be in accordance with the Olympic Parkwide CCTV Conversion Framework. It does not therefore require specific approval from the local planning authority.

Planning reference 11/90766/FUMODA is for the development of the Northern Parklands of the Olympic Legacy Park in Transformation, including public open space and Legacy Velopark facilities (1-mile road cycle circuit, off-road cycle (MTB) trails, Velopark bridges and car/cycle parking), highway amendments and associated hard and soft landscaping.
