Thank you for your information request, received on 22 February 2017. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"Copies of all correspondence either emails or letter between the LLDC and officials of the International Cricket Council or the England and Wales cricket board between 1st April 2016 and the date this request is received."

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation hold information relevant to your request. Searches were run across our email system for Legacy Corporation emails to or from the International Cricket Council (@icc-cricket.com) and the England and Wales Cricket Board (@ecb.co.uk); sent between the dates 1 April 2016 and 22 February 2017.

One email was found and it is attached in Annex A. Please note that it is the standard practice of the Legacy Corporation to redact personal information unless consent to release the information has been received.

Section 40(2) – personal information

- (2) Any information to which a request for information relates is also exempt information if—
- (a) it constitutes personal data which do not fall within subsection (1), and
- (b) either the first or the second condition below is satisfied.

The section 40 exemption is absolute and is not subject to the public interest test. In this instance, the relevant condition that applies is section 40(2) whereby the information is defined as personal data within Section 1(1)(a) of the Data Protection Act 1998. The redacted information includes the name and phone numbers of the send and the names of the recipients to this email. As we have not received consent of the data subject, release of the requested information at this time would contravene the first data principle under Schedule 2(1) of the Data Protection Act 1998.

If you are unhappy with our response to your request and wish to make a complaint or request a review of our decision, you should write to:
