Thank you for your information request, received on 19 May 2017. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) / Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

"1) From 1.1.2016 to present how many of the following planning applications has the LLDC received: Application for the change of use of a flat/house for short-term lets (temporary sleeping accommodation) (Sui Generis Use Class) for more than 90 days per calendar year.

2) From 1.1.2016 to present how many of the above mentioned planning applications were approved by the LLDC."

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information relevant to your request. Our response follows your order:

 From 1.1.2016 to present how many of the following planning applications has the LLDC received: Application for the change of use of a flat/house for short-term lets (temporary sleeping accommodation) (Sui Generis Use Class) for more than 90 days per calendar year.

Between the 1 January 2016 and the date of your request (19 May 2017) the Legacy Corporation has received one application as specified by your request.
