Thank you for your information request, received on 28 July 2017. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

*“Please release copies of correspondence between the LLDC and Essex County Cricket Club, the England and Wales Cricket Board or the International Cricket Committee relating to the hosting of cricket matches at the London Stadium. This includes emails, letters and minutes of meetings.”*

The Legacy Corporation does not hold any letters relevant to your request and has not held any meetings with Essex County Cricket Club, the England and Wales Cricket Board or the International Cricket Council in relation to the hosting of cricket matches at the London Stadium.

The London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) has also conducted searches for all correspondence sent and received between the Legacy Corporation and the domains @icc-cricket.com (*International Cricket Council*); @ecb.co.uk (*England and Wales Cricket Board*); and @essexcricket.org.uk (*Essex County Cricket Club*).

We have searched the Legacy Corporation's email archive from the date of your last request (17-013) on 22 February 2017 through to 28 July 2017 and these searches confirm that the Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested.
