Thank you for your information request, received on 16 February 2018. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) / Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

“Please supply me with any CLOS (Cycling Level of Service) assessments made by you or that TfL may have supplied to you in relation to the following TfL-funded Quietway projects as part of the design process Quietway 6 and any sections of the London Central Grid.

If no CLOS assessment was made by either yourself or was not supplied to you, please confirm that you do not hold the information.

If cost limits would be exceeded, please proceed with the requests in the order presented, up to the cost and time limit.”

The Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested in relation to Cycling Level of Service (CLOS) assessments for Quietway 6 and any sections of the Central London Cycling Grid.

The relevant Legacy Corporation directorates were consulted and they have confirmed that they do not hold this information. In addition to this, searches were run across the Legacy Corporation fileservers and no results were found for records with the search terms “cycling level of service”, “CLOS” or “Quietway” within the title.
