Thank you for your information request, received on 27 February 2018. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) and E20 Stadium LLP (E20) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Karren Brady of West Ham United FC recently quoted some statistics from a report by "Visit Football", The Premier League's independent Matchday Assessor. This report relates to the matchday experience at the London Stadium.

As owner of the stadium I would expect that you were provided with a copy of these reports and therefore, under FOI, I request a full copies of any reports you hold from Visit Football since August 2016.”

The Legacy Corporation and E20 do not hold the information you have requested.

Searches have been run across the Legacy Corporation and E20 fileservers using the search term “Visit Football”. Additional searches were undertaken across the Legacy Corporation and E20 email archives for any emails sent from West Ham to either the Legacy Corporation or E20, between the dates: 01/08/2016 and 27/02/2018 that contained the term “visit football”. A search was also run on any emails sent to or received by an @visitfootball.com email account. There were no results for any of these searches. Neither the Legacy Corporation nor E20 have received any reports under this name.
