Thank you for your information request, received on 3 April 2018. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“I would like to make the following freedom of information request:

Please provide information showing what major swimming events, e.g. national championships or similar significant or international events, have been hosted at the Aquatic Centre since the end of the Olympics/Paralympics.

Please provide information regarding any plans to host such events in the future.”

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information relevant to your request.

The London Aquatics Centre opened to the public in March 2014, and the details of the major national and international championships held at the venue since then are as follows:

There were no national/international competition events in the London Aquatics Centre in 2017. The Legacy Corporation is currently reviewing the opportunity to bring the FINA Diving Championships back to the Centre from 2019.

In addition, the London Aquatics Centre regularly hosts amateur galas and other similar events.
