Thank you for your information request, received on 14 May 2018. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"In 2012 the Olympic Delivery Authority, which I gather you have replaced, was given an award for which it has since been widely lauded - an award for having not a single construction-related fatality on the Olympic Park. However, I note 2011 reports such as the below suggesting a crane operator died in June 2011.

Can you please provide the health and safety reports from this incident, and confirm why it was not considered a construction-related death? Alternatively, please explain how the Londonist report is inaccurate."

The Legacy Corporation does not hold information in relation to this request. The incident referenced above occurred in the Olympic Village site and the Legacy Corporation did not take responsibility for this site on closure of the Olympic Delivery Authority (ODA). All of the ODA information not relevant to the Legacy Corporation was transferred to the Department of Digital, Culture, Media & Sport (DDCMS).
