Given the sensitivities and our primary desire to avoid any kind of disorder or disruption, I am planning to decline any requests we get to film or interview on QEOP land this weekend.

I wanted to make Lyn aware to ensure she is content.

Mark C and Tony – I wanted you to know so you were clear that any media activity that your team spotted was unauthorised

and **when** – wanted you to be aware given the wider ingress and egress stewarding and security operation and to make sure you were content that this was consistent with any policy you might have for Stadium Island

Mark R – our usual stance would be to allow this to happen away from the Stadium near F10 and the Aquatics: for this game I would like to decline all requests in any location

Dear Alan,

[PARAGRAPHS EXTRACTED WHERE THEY ARE NOT RELEVANT TO THE REQUEST

You will have read about a proposed march by thousands of our supporters against the club/stadium. This centers around two main issues our supporters have with the stadium. Firstly, they firmly believe that the stadium does not have the look and feel of the home of WHU. It saddens me deeply that our supporters feel that we have no regard for their desire to have their history and heritage adequately reflected during the football season at their home ground. You will know how that this principal was a cornerstone of our agreement when we agreed to move here and signed the Concession Agreement in 2013. The reason for this was we knew just how important it was to them and to their overall acceptance of the Stadium as their home.

The second frustration for them is that the seats are too far away from the pitch and are not retractable as per the video you sent to us in 2014, which we shared with them in good faith.

Dealing with the first frustration and with the objective of making the stadium look and feel more like the home of West Ham United to our supporters we are, as you are aware in the process of implementing the signage rights as per the concession agreement to achieve this. We have consulted with LS185 who are happy with the proposals and can confirm as per your request that this signage will carry West Ham branding and NOT feature any commercial partners. We will also work with LS185 to ensure they are satisfied that all branding displayed is sympathetic to removal and it goes without saying that it will be implemented at our own cost.

West Ham United's supporters acceptance of the Stadium as their home ground has real genuine benefits for all of us; their affinity with the Stadium means they enjoy their time here and on the park more and are more likely to want to dwell longer and spend money – benefitting you and LS185, our staff (including LS185's) are happier because our supporters are happier and the overall perception of the Stadium and its overall success is enhanced rather than being the subject of negative media scrutiny. I need not tell you the damage that any kind of march at the Stadium would do and of course it benefits no-one and I feel it is deeply regretful that we have allowed it to come to this when the issues which are causing our supporters concern, when you get to the crux of them are a combination of a host of very small matters that could be so easily resolved to our mutual benefit.
