INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE 18-066

Thank you for your information request, received on 1 October 2018. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR):

“Please could you provide details in respect of Pudding Mill Allotments:

- a. The physical make-up of the soil installation.*
- b. The physical surface and subterranean plans of the site.*
- c. Results of soil analyses for the site in respect of design, sourcing, and post-installation.*
- d. Results of soil and respective compaction tests made at site post-installation, and recommendations in respect of the testing.”*

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information which falls within the scope of your request. Please find attached, in **Annex A to Annex U**, the information identified as relevant to your request.

Please note that the area of the allotments was known under the terms Bridgewater Road and South Park Landscaping. The annexes are in date order starting from the earliest date.

Please note that personal information has been redacted under EIR regulation 13 – personal data.

EIR regulation 13 – personal data

(1) To the extent that the information requested includes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject, a public authority must not disclose the personal data if—
(a) the first condition is satisfied, or

(b) the second or third condition is satisfied and, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in not disclosing the information outweighs the public interest in disclosing it.”

*(2) The first condition is that the disclosure of the information to a member of the public otherwise than under these Regulations—
(a) would contravene any of the data protection principles,*

It is the standard practice of the Legacy Corporation to redact personal information for those members of staff under Head of Service level, and for non-Legacy Corporation personnel unless consent to release the information has been received.
