Dear Sir,

Thank you for your information request, received on 8 October 2018. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

“Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000, we request the following information in relation to post-Games development works at the Athletes Village: Dates between which Madigan Gill and its staff were authorised to access the site of the Athletes Village, both in relation to pre-Games and post-Games development works;

The name of the contractor or sub-contractor responsible for waste management, traffic management and general logistics in relation to plots N13 and N26 between 2011-2013; and

A list of all contractors and/or sub-contractors responsible for traffic management and logistics at the site of the Athletes Village between 2011 to 2013 inclusive.”

The Legacy Corporation does not hold the information you have requested. The Legacy Corporation has had no responsibility for the design, development, operation or maintenance of Athlete’s village. The Olympic Delivery Authority (ODA) managed the reconfiguration and disposal of the village post-Games. On closure the ODA information was transferred to the Department of Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS). Details of how to submit a FOIA request to DCMS can be found on their website:
