Happy New Year (if it's not too late to say so). Don't think we have been in touch since 2017.

As I am sure you will be aware I put in a FOI request to ascertain who you were dealing with at LBTH regarding adoption of the bridges and now have the information which I was seeking, which is that it is Margaret Cooper. I have no idea what the big secret was at the LLDC end and I have now been in touch with Margaret. Hopefully with us both acting in concert we can effect the changes we need more speedily.

The seemingly pointless secrecy, in view of being able to ascertain the information via FOI has led, I am told, to extra expense being incurred by the taxpayer in demolishing Vittoria Wharf. This is a real shame and was totally unnecessary, but what's happened has happened. I am sorry this had to happen. The LLDC have to bear responsibility for this.

In receiving correspondence from my FOI request, there were two other particular comments which I found interesting and somewhat amusing...

The first is an email to you on 20 October last year, from a Senior Development Manager () where the PS stated "Well done on not letting Forman chase LBTH himself" also with four exclamation marks afterwards!!!! Can we meet up for a drink one day and you can

explain to me why everyone at the LLDC is so secretive or afraid. Maybe I'm being dumb, but I really don't get it!!!!! (note, five exclamations there)

The second is an email from you to Janet Townsend on 19 May last year. referring to the 1-1.5m strip. You state "We can either frustrate his development entirely, which is one possibility, or suggest some suitable terms for him to buy it from us". Thanks for that Tony. Much appreciated. If I recall we had those conversations then and you are now clear that it was the LDA's intention in agreeing this option that the purpose was always to allow us to connect to the bridge, so a 1-1.5m gap doesn't really cut it.... or maybe it does? I get that Tony Hollingsworth has attempted to frustrate the development entirely. Is this part of the LLDC's strategy.

Hopefully we can make some sensible and practical progress this year and put the politics and skulduggery to one side.

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

My apologies for the delay in responding to this request. I can confirm that we hold information relevant to your request and I have provided a fuller explanation of the delay to our response below.

The Freedom of Information Act obliges us to respond to requests promptly and no later than 20 working days after receiving your request. However, when a qualified exemption applies to the information and the public interest test is engaged, the Act allows the time for response to be longer than 20 working days, and a full response must be provided within such time as is

reasonable in all circumstances of the case.

We do, of course, aim to make all decisions within 20 working days, including in cases where we need to consider the public interest test. In this case, however, we have not yet reached a decision on where the balance of the public interest lies.

In your case we have estimated that it will take an additional 20 working days to take a decision on where the balance of the public interest lies. Therefore, we hope to be able to have a response by 2 February 2018. If it appears that it will take longer than this to reach a decision, we will keep you informed. If we are able to provide you with our response before this date, we will obviously do so.

The exemption that applies in relation to your request and that requires the extra time in order to consider the public interest is: section 43 (2) – Information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of any person (including the public authority holding it).

We will keep you informed of our progress and provide you with our response to your request as soon as we are able.

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
