Dear Sir

Thank you for your information request, received on 18 February 2019. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"Could you give me the information of stakeholders (like stakeholder mapping) of the planning of Olympic Park and Rick Roberts Way."

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information which falls within the scope of your request, however, we are refusing your request under FOIA section 21 as the information is reasonably accessible by other means.

s.21 - Information accessible to applicant by other means.

- (1) Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant otherwise than under section 1 is exempt information.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1)—
- (a) information may be reasonably accessible to the applicant even though it is accessible only on payment, and
- (b) information is to be taken to be reasonably accessible to the applicant if it is information which the public authority or any other person is obliged by or under any enactment to communicate (otherwise than by making the information available for inspection) to members of the public on request, whether free of charge or on payment.

The Legacy Communities Scheme (LCS) planning permission includes the Statement of Participation which covers extensive pre-submission engagement with stakeholders.

This document is publicly available on our planning register under planning application reference: 11/90621/OUTODA.

Within the planning application, the information requested is within the Documents tab. Search for 'statement of participation'. Please be advised that due to the size the document is in three parts.
