Thank you for your information request, received on 30 July 2019. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

- How many planning applications for small cell sites or distributed antennae systems for 5G did you receive during 2018?
- 2. How many planning applications for small cell sites or distributed antennae systems for 5G did you approve during 2018?
- 3. How many planning applications for small cell or distributed antennae systems for 5G have you received since January 1st 2019?
- 4. How many planning applications for small cell sites or distributed antennae systems for 5G have been approved since January 1st 2019?
- 5. How many planning applications were followed by street work permit requests or similar in 2018?
- 6. How many planning applications were followed by street work permit requests or similar in 2019?
- 7. How many street work permits have been granted in since January 1st 2019?

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information which falls within the scope of your request.

The information relevant to your request is below and our response follows your order:

1. <u>How many planning applications for small cell sites or distributed antennae systems</u> for 5G did you receive during 2018?

- 2. <u>How many planning applications for small cell sites or distributed antennae systems</u> for 5G did you approve during 2018?
- 3. <u>How many planning applications for small cell or distributed antennae systems for 5G have you received since January 1st 2019?</u>
- 4. <u>How many planning applications for small cell sites or distributed antennae systems</u> for 5G have been approved since January 1st 2019?

In answer to your questions 1 – 4, all of the information requested is in the public domain, available via the planning register - <a href="http://planningregister.londonlegacy.co.uk/swift/apas/run/wphappcriteria.display">http://planningregister.londonlegacy.co.uk/swift/apas/run/wphappcriteria.display</a>. From here you can search for specific terms (small cell sites / antennae / 5G / etc.), periods of time, application types (Telecommunications App / Part 16 Prior Notification Telecomms), etc.

5. <u>How many planning applications were followed by street work permit requests or similar in 2018?</u>

The Legacy Corporation does not issue street works permits, therefore I can confirm the Legacy Corporation does not hold this information.

6. <u>How many planning applications were followed by street work permit requests or similar in 2019?</u>
