First of all sorry for the slow response but be assured my team have been looking into the matter as soon as we received your letter.

Thank you for your email as we share your concerns around some of the current operations. The point around apparent dust from the site has already been raised with DB Cargo which we will be following up shortly. We will also be exploring the idea of setting up a Management Committee with DBC and the various sub-tenants and how this might interact with key neighbours particularly the school

Separately but connected and so you are aware my team have recently raised an issue with your team around highways in the locality and in zebra crossing on Marshgate Lane linking Pudding Mill Station to the DRET school which is seen as a cause for concern. Perhaps the highways authority can resolve in the short term rather than wait for future proposals to help solve the issues which will only intensify as the school becomes busier.

I look forward to us meeting on the 4 July to discuss progress on the wider redevelopment opportunity.
