Thank you for your information request, received on 1 November 2019. You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"I would like to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act to receive minutes of any meetings of the Park Panel since 2016, where Madison Square Garden company (MSG) is present or where the MSG Sphere is discussed."

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation hold information relevant to your request. There have been four Park Panel meetings where MSG were either present or where the MSG Sphere was discussed. Please find details of the relevant minutes below:

It is the standard practice of the Legacy Corporation to redact personal information for those members of staff under Head of Service level, and for non-Legacy Corporation personnel unless consent to release the information has been received.

The section 40 exemption is absolute and is not subject to the public interest test. In this instance, the relevant condition that applies is section 40(2) whereby the information is defined as personal data within s.3(2) of the Data Protection Act 2018.
