Thank you for your information request, received on 13 November 2019, following on from FOI 19-068 (attached for reference). You asked the London Legacy Development Corporation (Legacy Corporation) to provide the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA):

"I would however now also like to know who attended these meetings on behalf of LLDC. If this isn't possible I'd like to know what position they held in the organisation. If this isn't possible I'd like to know what level they were at e.g. officer, executive etc.

Please accept this as another request under the Freedom of Information Act."

I can confirm that the Legacy Corporation holds information relevant to your request. The meeting on 4 May 2018 Stratford Gardens – S106 was attended by the following Legacy Corporation personnel:

LLDC-A: Principal Planning Development Manager (Planning Policy and Decisions team). Band 6.

The meeting on 11 May 2018 Stratford Gardens – Daylight/Sunlight was attended by the following Legacy Corporation personnel:

Catherine Smyth: Head of Development Management (Planning Policy and Decisions). Band 7.

LLDC-A: Principal Planning Development Manager (Planning Policy and Decisions team). Band 6.

LLDC-B: Design Principal. Development Team. Band 6.

Catherine Smyth's name was previously redacted in error in the minutes. The minutes have been revised to show her name.

The other two personnel have not consented to have their names released, therefore their personal information is being withheld under FOIA section 40:

Section 40(2) – personal information

(2) Any information to which a request for information relates is also exempt information if –

*(a) it constitutes personal data which does not fall within subsection (1), and
(b) the first, second or third condition below is satisfied.*

It is the standard practice of the Legacy Corporation to redact personal information for those members of staff under Head of Service level, and for non-Legacy Corporation personnel unless consent to release the information has been received.

The section 40 exemption is absolute and is not subject to the public interest test. In this instance, the relevant condition that applies is section 40(2) whereby the information is defined as personal data within s.3(2) of the Data Protection Act 2018.

Please note, the minutes have been revised to identify which specific individual from LLDC is related to each Legacy Corporation reference within the minutes.
